

CCB Behavioral Research Funding Pool Application Process – (11/17/22)

Costello College of Business has created a funding source for behavioral research projects undertaken by faculty. Examples of uses include experiment participant payment, survey participant payment, Interview/focus group payment, and transcription. All full-time faculty are eligible to apply. Priority will be given applications submitted by tenure-track faculty and to those whose submitted papers have received a request for a revision from a Premier or Superior journal where the feedback calls for additional data gathering. Project requests can be up to \$2500. Note that this fund is not to be used for data sets or travel.

Application Process:

1. ½ to 1-page summary of the project, target journal, and stage of project (e.g., revision received)
2. Copy of IRB Approval-This can be submitted after the initial proposal but is needed for any funding to be released.
3. Description of use of funds
4. Estimate of cost
5. Timeline of fund use and overall project
6. Short note of approval from area chair

Application should be emailed to Mira Sharma (msharma9@gmu.edu), with a copy to Cheryl Druehl (cdruehl@gmu.edu). Note that these funds will be distributed and monitored centrally to ensure fair and timely action.

Expected approval time is approximately 2 weeks. Review of applications and approval will be by the Associate Dean for Research.

Once funding approval is received, you would be directed to follow the process for acquiring the funds.

Funds should be expended in the fiscal year in which these are awarded.

Source of funds should be acknowledged in all work products that are enabled or facilitated with the award.
